Junior wing Devonte Malcolm leads the Colts in scoring at 12.1 per game, but when he gets hot, he can really be devastating from the three-point line. The other important junior is Merle Branch who is scoring 10.3 per contest, but maybe more importantly, is dishing out 4.8 assists a game. Buena struggled early this season in the Salpointe Tip Off Classic, including a loss to Rincon, but don't expect them to be happy looking to the future. They are coming together and will be a dangerous team this year

The Rangers needed a win last night and after a slow scoring first half (25-17), they got it together and got the job done. Billy Morrison led the Rangers with 30 points on 10-26 shooting. His ability to get to the line and convert (10-13) helped up his total and tenacity on the glass (19 rebounds) kept him active. Juan Pablo Favela had a decent performance as well, finishing with 13 points and 6 rebounds. The visiting Apaches shot terribly. As a team they were 13-56 (23%) from the floor and 6-15 (40%) from the line. Some credit to the Rincon defense for challenging outside shots and dominating on the boards.
