Buena got off to a great start to their section season last Thursday by beating Cienega in Sierra Vista. Five Colts scored 9 or more and helped hand the Bobcats only their second loss of the season. The Colts feature a balanced attack that is headed by guard Rodney Springer, who will look to push the tempo and penetrate the key. Gilbert Pinckney is Buena's muscle inside, but at 6-4, he is giving up considerable size to the Rincon posts, which will again be relied upon to have a strong performance tonight. Mojave Nick is the other main scorer for the Colts, but they will have an onslaught of serviceable role players that can contribute as well. This is a big week for the Rangers with two home contests that could have big implications on the postseason down the road

Section Preview

Today begins the section season for the Rangers. As the start of a new two-year block, there has again been realignment. This year, southern Arizona is divided into two sections with Rincon residing in Division II Section II. The other teams in the section are Amphi, Buena, Catalina, Cienega, Desert View, Douglas, Empire, Nogales, Pueblo, Rio Rico, Sabino, Sahuaro, and Sunnyside. All teams will play a true round robin consisting of 13 games. The top four teams by record will advance to the sectional tournament with the state tournament being determined after. Buena, Cienega, and Sahuaro are the favorites in the section after returning many of their players from strong teams last season; however, there are many other contenders for the coveted four spots.

CDO 70 Rincon 68

The Rangers started last Friday's game on the wrong foot and it came back to bite them in the end. Rincon was cold for the first four minutes and fell behind 13-0 before finally getting going. Jason Chamberlain got the Rangers started with a couple buckets and a few trips to the line where he finished 8 of 9, part of his team high 16 points. For the Dorados, Lauren Hampton broke down the defense and made dishes to Ty Ochse who scored 19 in the first half. The Rangers made up the 12-point halftime deficit in the third quarter with some buckets inside from Brendan Rumel, who totaled 13 points and 9 rebounds in the game. Austin Guerrero (14 points) and Jesus Nunez (11 points) helped fueled the run but CDO held on in the fourth quarter to take the win.
