## Tonight's Matchup:

For the first time this year, the Rangers play a team that can match up with them at both post positions. While not matching in height, the Dorados inside duo of Ty Ochse and John Jackson are strong inside and will challenge the sophomore big men of Rincon, who is also working Jesus Nunez back into the rotation. The other player to watch for CDO is point guard Jacob Hampton, who is quick off the dribble and will attempt to get into the heart of the Ranger D. The Dorados will look to push the pace between Hampton and reserve guard Gilbert Cadelinia. This game marks the start of a three-game home stand for the Rangers with the following two next Monday and Friday against section opponents Buena and Cienega respectively.

## Rincon 73 Santa Rita 64

Last Thursday night, the Rangers welcomed the Eagles in their first home game of the year and took home the victory. Rincon jumped out to a 13-2 lead but let Santa Rita back into the game in the third quarter giving away 6 points from their 8-point halftime lead. Balanced scoring from the Rangers (19 from Jason Chamberlain, 18 from Brendan Rumel, and 17 from Austin Guerrero) were enough to hold off the Eagles in the fourth quarter. Rincon Freshmen and JV also picked up victories, giving the program a sweep. Tonight's game with CDO is the only remaining non-section home game for the Rangers, with only a trip to Ironwood Ridge remaining on their non-league schedule.

## Foothills 80 Rincon 53

The Rangers cut the Falcons lead to six early in the third quarter but would never get any closer. Catalina Foothills, a favorite to win the Division II state championship, steadily built their lead until the game was out of hand. Brendan Rumel scored a team-high 24 points on 7-11 shooting from the field but no other Rincon player got into double figures. On the other side of the ball, Austin Nehls and Chaz Mack combined for 45 for the Falcons. When it wasn't the two main guys, it was the role players. Austin Miller broke down the Rangers defense and Dalton Groenewold and Dakota Kordseimon did all the clean up work. The Falcons went on to drop their first game of the season earlier this week at Cienega, Rincon's last opponent before the winter break (next Friday).
