The Rangers begin the stretch run of sectional games this evening versus the visiting Jaguars, fresh off of their blowout win against Buena on Monday. This is the strongest Desert View squad in quite some time. Their lineups often feature five guards playing a pace and space offense designed to draw defending post players into mismatches on the perimeter. Rincon's advantage, as usual, comes on the inside. If the Rangers are able to limit turnovers and move the Jaguar zone, they should be able to convert easy opportunities in the paint and grab a victory that would help them creep back closer to the targeted top 4 spots in the section.

The Rangers struggled to get anything going, especially on the offensive end of the floor. Brendan Rumel again led with 11 points and James Chabin and Max Siath each added 8 but the guard line failed to get on the board. Ironwood Ridge led from start to finish and now heads into their section schedule where they stand a good chance to finish in the top four and advance to sectionals. The loss dropped the Rangers back to 30th in power points, currently out of the state playoff picture; only 24 teams qualify. Luckily, their remaining games should boost their strength of schedule.
