### Tonight's Matchup

Run it back. These teams met only 11 days ago in the opener of the Salpointe Tip Off Classic. The Falcons led start to finish but never by more than 10 points. Tonight the Rangers try to even the season series in a game that counts towards power point rankings. Nik Nehls led Catalina Foothills in scoring the first time around, scoring 16 points on 3-7 three-point shooting. Senior leader Dakota Kordsiemon was not a major factor in the first contest but will figure to be tonight. The Falcons hurt the Rangers both on the glass and from behind the arc, both areas that look to be strengths of this Rincon team. Those will be primary battlegrounds for both squads tonight and likely the more successful team in those spots will emerge with a big non-section win tonight.

### Rincon 78 Santa Rita 49

The Rangers rolled through the Eagles last night en route to their first road victory of the season. Juan Figueroa got Rincon started early, scoring the first two buckets. The Rangers jumped to an early lead, making 7 of their first 9 shots and never looked back. Santa Rita was without their top player, Itury Kitt, who should return for the second half of the season and lead them as contenders in Division III Section V. The Rangers got contributions from many different players, including Max Siath's career-high 11 points and 6 rebounds and Figueroa's team-high 13 points and 6 deflections. Thomas Wabaunsee added 10 points, 5 assists and 4 steals.

Walden Grove had no answer for the Rincon big men as Rumel dominated the offensive end and David Kerry the defensive end, blocking 6 shots of his own and grabbing 9 rebounds. Christian Hagedon continues to give great performances off the bench, shooting 5-8 from the floor and 4-4 from the line for 14 points. He also pulled down 5 rebounds and added 4 assists.
