Sunnyside 58 Rincon 50

Last Friday's matchup determined who would get to play for the 6A Southern Region championship and unfortunately the Blue Devils came out on top. Both teams struggled to score early and with a third quarter run which boosted the Sunnyside lead to 12, Rincon was forced to chase the rest of the way. Christian Bahige was electric off the bench, scoring 15 points and dishing 4 assists, creating most of the offensive for the Rangers. Malik Hunter was solid, chipping in 13 points and 12 rebounds. Sunnyside, Rincon, and Tucson all finished 2-2 but Sunnyside won the tiebreak (conference record), leaving the Rangers just outside the postseason picture.

Rincon 64 Tucson 61

In a rematch of a Badger victory two weeks prior, the Rangers jumped out early and controlled the game, carrying an eight point lead into the fourth quarter. After Tucson High pulled ahead midway through the final period, Rincon battled back and took the lead with thirty seconds remaining on an outstanding steal and three-pointer by Estevan Sandoval. After two Badger free throws, Christian Bahige scored the winning basket. The Rangers got big contributions from Malik Hunter, Japhon Harrison, Jon Mueller, and Joey Cable, who scored 13, 11, 11, and 8 respectively. Each pulled down 7 rebounds in the contest. With the loss, Tucson fell to third in the region.
